

2017-2018 NWSE Program to Germany



As a student on our One-Way and Reciprocal Program you would be placed by NWSE in or near cities like Freiburg or Berlin, but some placements are with host families in smaller communities. German host families provide room and board for you and want you to participate actively in their daily life, just like a member of their family. Students usually attend the local *Gymnasium* where they take regular classes together with their German peers, unless they choose to take intensive German classes instead (at their own expense – however, we will be happy to help arrange such classes!). Current formal study of German, at least one year of successfully studying high school German, or proof of the equivalent (such as summer intensive language study) is required.



The program includes:

- Room and board with a carefully selected volunteer host family
- Supervision by an NWSE representative in Germany
- Enrollment in a German high school
- Travel insurance (if chosen)
- A German language afternoon or evening course in Germany for 40 lessons (for One-Way Exchange participants only; total value up to \$350)
- Pre-departure and post-arrival student orientations
- Orientation for the host family in Germany
- Advising and counseling, when needed, throughout the application process and program
- Upon successful program completion: NWSE certificate of participation



Not included in program fees:

- Flights (NWSE can help you book an affordable flight), passport fees, or other travel-related expenses
- Fee for German Residence Permit (approx. 100 Euros)
- School supplies
- Lunch, if you do not to pack a lunch from your host family home
- Spending money for personal expenses, including for public transportation (NWSE recommends at least \$200-\$250 per month for duration of program)
