# 2018-19 NWSE Germany Study Abroad Program



Germany is a vibrant, culturally diverse country and a world leader in renewable energy technologies, manufacturing, tourism, and the arts. It enjoys successful schools, accessible public transportation, historic city centers, and livable, pedestrian-friendly communities. Students will be immersed in German culture by living with a host family and attending the 10<sup>th</sup> or 11<sup>th</sup> grade at a *Gymnasium* or Gesamtschule. NWSE will arrange after-school German lessons to help accelerate your language acquisition. You should also plan to join other after-school and community activities together with your German peers, so you can further improve your language skills, find friends, and learn about German culture.

### Requirements for Eligibility

- Between the ages of 15 and 18 at the start of the program
- Current enrollment (2017-18) in 9th-11th grade at an accredited high school
- Minimum grade point average (GPA) of 3.0 (out of 4.0)
- Current formal study of German and successful completion of one year of high school German at the start of the program; motivation to experience German culture
- Successful completion of German language test
- Maturity, good character, scholastic aptitude
- Good physical and mental health

#### **Included in Program Fees**

- Room and board with a carefully selected volunteer host family
- Supervision by an NWSE coordinator in Germany
- Enrollment in a public high school
- A German language course twice a week after school
- Pre-departure and post-arrival orientations
- Advising and counseling throughout the application process and program, as needed
- Upon successful program completion: NWSE Certificate of Participation

#### **Not Included in Program Fees**


- Flights, passport fees, or other travel-related expenses
